Memoirists and essayists, here's your chance to say it all in just a few words. This year, *Talking Writing* will award the first TW Prize for Flash Nonfiction. The judge is Dinty W. Moore, editor of *Brevity Magazine*.

Length: 500 words or less.

Deadline: October 1, 2014.

Topics: Creative nonfiction, a mini-essay, or a tiny memoir on any theme. The key is "flash." Award: The winner of the 2014 TW Prize for Flash Nonfiction will receive \$250 and publication in *Talking Writing*. In addition, TW editors will consider all contest entries for publication.

Judge: Dinty W. Moore is editor of <u>Brevity</u> [4], the online journal of flash nonfiction. A professor of nonfiction writing at Ohio University, he's the author of *The Mindful Writer: Noble Truths of the Writing Life* and a memoir, *Between Panic & Desire*.

A: Yes. You can also submit entries for the <u>2014 TW Prize for Writing Advice</u> [5], judged by Emily Toth ("Ms. Mentor" of the *Chronicle of Higher Education*).
